

SKILLS VICTORIA FUNDING

The Victorian Training Guarantee is making vocational education and training more accessible to people who do not hold a post-school qualification, or who want to gain a higher level qualification than they already hold. Now is the ideal time to make a start on obtaining new skills or upgrading existing skills.

Government-subsidised training places are available to people who meet the specific eligibility criteria.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A GOVERNMENT SUBSIDISED TRAINING PLACE?

You can check your eligibility at the [Victorian Skills Gateway Eligibility Indicator](#) alternatively you can follow the following steps in the eligibility assessment below.

ELIGIBILITY ASSESSMENT	
<p>Please complete the following questions to determine your eligibility for subsidised training. Training services are provided to Eligible Individuals with funds made available by the Victorian and Commonwealth Governments. To be eligible for Victorian and Commonwealth Government subsidised training, you must be a resident of Victoria</p>	
STEP 1	<p>Are you an Australian Citizen or a New Zealand Citizen or Holder of a Permanent Visa</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes – go to step 2 <input type="checkbox"/> No – not eligible</p>
STEP 2	<p>Are you enrolled in a school, detained in a youth justice facility, held in prison or detained in Thomas Embling Hospital?</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes – not eligible <input type="checkbox"/> No – go to step 3</p>
STEP 3	<p>What age are you on the 1st January 2015?</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Under 20 years of age – go to step 6 <input type="checkbox"/> Over 20 years of age – go to step 4</p>
STEP 4	<p>Have you previously completed any formal qualifications?</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes – go to step 5 <input type="checkbox"/> No – go to step 6</p>
STEP 5	<p>Are you enrolling in a course that is a higher qualification level than the previously completed qualification (i.e. learner holds a Cert II and is enrolling in Cert III qualification)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Yes – go to step 6 <input type="checkbox"/> No – not eligible</p>
STEP 6	<p>Not including the course/s you are seeking to enroll in now, how many other government subsidised courses have you “enrolled to undertake” this year? Include training you have enrolled in to undertake at this and other training providers but not started yet. Note: A learner can only undertake a maximum of two (2) government funded courses in 2015</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Two(2) or more – not eligible <input type="checkbox"/> One(1) – go to step 7 <input type="checkbox"/> None(0) – go to step 7</p>
STEP 7	<p>Not including the course/s you are seeking to enroll in now, how many other government subsidised courses are you undertaking training in at the moment</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Two(2) or more – not eligible <input type="checkbox"/> One(1) – go to step 8 <input type="checkbox"/> None(0) – go to step 8</p>
STEP 8	<p>In your lifetime, how many government subsidised courses have you started (commenced) that are at the same level as the one you are applying for now? Note: A learner can only undertake a maximum of two (2) government funded courses at the same AQF level in their lifetime.(i.e. Certificate III)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Two(2) or more – not eligible <input type="checkbox"/> One(1) – eligible go to step 9 <input type="checkbox"/> None(0) – eligible go to step 9</p>

Note:

You must enroll, commence and complete training in a course or qualification provided by 1 Stop Driving School between the 1st January 2015 and 31 December 2015 inclusive.

Please be advised that when you enrol in a government subsidised qualification in 2015 that this may affect you being able to access further government subsidised training.
